SPECIAL NOTICE

New Educational Class Signup/Payment Policy

Due to the popularity of our classes, the Board has changed the sign up and payment requirements so others on our educational class waiting lists can have significant notification to participate if for some reason someone has to drop out of a class before it begins. The new policy requires that all classes are first come/first served as long as they pay for the class one week before the class begins! If payment is not received before one week of the class then that spot is Sandra McMillan forfeited and members on waiting list will be contacted to fill the class.

> In the past, the unwritten policy was that payment could be made when you attended the first class. This created unfilled classes as it is only natural that factors beyond members control such as sickness, last minute scheduling conflicts and other issues sometimes happen that makes it impossible to attend. However, without notification or the time to give adequate notification, this created unfilled classes at the last minute and did not give us or the instructor time to reach out to those on the waiting list for the class. This is unfair to the instructor who had prepared and many times has to prepare materials for their classes. It is also unfair to other members who would have liked to take the class but could not receive notification in time.

> The Board believes this is a policy that is fair for all members and that is our #1 priority when making policy decisions. Thank you for your understanding!

SHOP NOTES

Shop News:

As a supervisor AND shop manager...I sometimes find myself lamenting my chance to use the shop for myself...always busy fixing or repairing or replacing or moving or installing. You get the idea. Well having just wrapped up the router table class...I as an instructor and member can REALLY appreciate this gift (the WEC) that keeps on giving. We really went after sleds, and fences and jigs and drill bits (of all kinds) and pencils and specialty hammers, measuring aids and when combined with the room to get deep into the project without wanting for most anything - the results can be fulfilling. Special thanks to my top notch teaching partner David Robinson - spot on brother! Richard Strahan, Jim Keith and David Lewis all came away appreciating the shops value in our midst...they gave a great shout out.

Update on the ChopSaw / DownDraft Table project? The design is complete, the table saw station is done (complete with automatic/dedicated shop vac!). The downdraft table is complete minus a fan swap out. The fans I bought were not enough (heavily suspicious from the get go on that one myself), but new MUCH stronger fans are on the way. AND we installed three new small port vacuum stations at the new downdraft table. The combo of dust collection AND downdraft should go a long way to helping with fine particulate dust (made in large quantities by small sanders as we all know).

Lastly. a shop need. Not a big one, but an essential one. Fasteners...wood screws to be specific. How about you grab a small box (you know the \$1.18 bags or plastic boxes, we all hate that crappy box...) of wood screws for the shop. If you grab more than one...grab all one size. If 10 people do this...it will make an impact. Put them in the library on top of the shop manager tool box. Or give them directly to any supervisor...they will put them on the toolbox for you.

Extra lastly...the shop is closed Friday night May 18th and all Saturday May 19th for the 10-year celebration!!!
